Later as a married couple they helped a church plant in Minneapolis, they were directors of Columbus Teen Challenge (OH), and pastored an inner-city church in Columbus. They have served in Honduras, Costa Rica, & Panama as Missionaries since 2005. They have trained and developed Teen Challenge leadership using Teen Challenge and Living Free materials. Their last term was in Panama where they redeveloped the Teen Challenge ministry and incorporated the Living Free ministry to facilitate discipleship within the church for those struggling with addictions, strongholds, and bondage.
